<p>SAA Swimming Proficiency</p> <p>Held off-site at the Buona Vista Swimming Complex, Holland Drive. The swimmers travel by school bus to the pool escorted by teachers and teacher's assistants. Teacher: Child ratio is 1:3.</p>	Mondays	9.15am-11am	<p>This popular swimming proficiency course is run by Meng. Meng has been coaching children from 6 months old for 14 years. He is a registered coach and is on the National Register of the Singapore Sports Council</p> <p>Swimming Coaches. Meng is CPR and First Aid trained. He has also taught a few of the teacher's children how to swim.</p>
<p>Fees: Term fees are \$267.50 per 10-week term. There is a deposit of \$100 which is fully refundable on four term weeks' written notice of withdrawal.</p>			<p>The course is designed to meet the needs of the emergent swimmer and the more confident swimmer. For the emergent swimmer, water confidence is the focus whilst for the confident swimmer, it is stroke technique and distance confidence.</p> <p><i>Maximum number of participants is 10 students. Currently, there is a wait list.</i></p>
<p>Sportball</p> <p>Held on-site at Swallows and Amazons Kindergarten. The children participate in their class peer groups.</p> <p>Open to all registered students, including those who do not normally attend school on Thursdays.</p>	Thursdays	Class slots during the morning and afternoon	<p>By applying our methodology... Sportball helps children to develop socially as well as physically, through a curriculum designed to reinforce self-confidence free from the pressure of competition. In our programs, children from 16 months to 12 years of age, are provided with a skills-driven, high-energy and fun-filled curriculum.</p> <p>Sportball Multi-Sport programs introduce children to the fundamental concepts and skills behind eight popular ball sports: baseball, football, basketball, golf, hockey, soccer, tennis and volleyball. Using creative instruction and positive encouragement, our programs focus on the development of gross motor skills, along with balance, strength, co-ordination, stamina and timing. The equipment that we use is age-appropriate and sized just right for the children in our programs.</p>
<p>Fees: Term fees are \$184.50 per 10-week term. There is a two calendar weeks' written notice of withdrawal.</p>			
<p>Skygym</p> <p>Held off-site in the main Turf City Building. The children are escorted to the Skygym with their teachers and teacher's assistants.</p> <p>Open to all SAA registered students, including those who do not normally attend school on Friday afternoons.</p>	Fridays	2pm-3pm	<p>KinderGym (2 - 5 years old)</p> <p>Skygym's KinderGym classes are designed for kids to participate in basic gymnastics without their parents, while interacting with other children and a coach. At this level the students learn educational gymnastics, structure, and discipline. They will develop their gross motor skills like jumping, hopping, balancing and learning how to land safely. Co-ordination and confidence are built in a fun filled positive atmosphere.</p> <p><i>Maximum number of participants is 30.</i></p>
<p>Fees: \$16 per lesson payable per Skygym Term. There is a two calendar weeks' written notice of withdrawal.</p>
